

Guidelines for In-Person, Outdoor Worship and events at Temple Beth Torah

- Attendees must RSVP by either responding to the evite, emailing <u>admin@bethtorah-fremont.org</u> or calling the office by noon on Friday mornings for services or weekend events or the prior day for other events.
- Upon arrival, a member from each household will be asked to sign-in, providing names of all attending family members, for the purpose of potential contact tracing.
- At the sign-in table we will have Service Pamphlets as well as paper "vaccinated" blue wristbands for those who want to voluntarily, selfidentify as vaccinated.
- Any household that is not fully vaccinated, which includes any household with children, is asked to sit and stay six feet apart from others.
- Chairs will be available. Please let someone know if you need help repositioning chairs to meet your household's distancing needs.
- The restrooms will be open; the rest of the building will not.
- Please bring bottled water with you (if desired), and wear clothing appropriate for the weather.
- Please bring your own kippah and tallit, if desired.
- Everyone present (above 2 years old) will wear masks at all times. Only the
 rabbi and anyone helping to lead the service may remove their mask while
 leading. At services or events where food is provided, masks may be removed
 while eating, please replace them when you are finished.
- For the present time, other than the service leader, there will be no singing.
